## Message from Cheyenne Alumni

Mid 2007-08, the Clark County School District was asked to make cuts to their already limited budget. Additional cuts in 2008 brought the total decrease in state education funding to \$173.1 million dollars, causing a nearly 11% budget cut for K-12 education. The result was significant cut-backs in operational budgets, including the loss of funding for empowerment schools and the elimination of critical programs.

***Cheyenne High School is the first empowerment high school in Las Vegas.***

For 2009, superintendents and school boards expected a projected 14.1% decrease in funding, equaling an approximately \$263.8 million dollars of further cuts. School officials also projecting that enrollment would grow by 0.7 percent.

The need for organizations and the community to come together and help support local schools is apparent. A non-profit Alumni Association is underway, dedicated to providing support for Cheyenne High School. The Cheyenne High School Alumni hope to enrich the educational experience and student outcome for future Cheyenne High School Alumni through continuous alumni networking, fundraising events, and student outreach.
